



## **2 Day Horsemanship Clinic and Free 4-H Clinic, Washington County Fairgrounds, Brenham, TX, March 3-4, 2012, Indoor Arena**

### **DESCRIPTION**

This clinic is for riders of any age and discipline who are interested in improving their horsemanship, want to learn how to better understand what their horse is thinking as well as how to provide appropriate leadership, or have a specific problem, such as bucking, rearing or head tossing, that you'd like to overcome. All horses must be broke to ride and riders must provide their own hay and supplements.

Kerry has earned a reputation in the clinic industry for being an incredible communicator with both horses and riders and emphasizes having fun as much as learning and safety. Clinic topics will include, but are not limited to:

- Creating willingness in both horse and rider
- Developing softness from head to tail
- Learning how to use fluid forward motion in your training
- Building total body control
- Overcoming anxiety in each of you / developing confidence
- Groundwork principles and exercises
- Passenger exercises and problem solving

Day 1 will focus on Kerry's Level 1 principles while day 2 focuses on Kerry's level 2 principles, which are available on-line at [www.kerrykuhn.com/clinicschedule.html](http://www.kerrykuhn.com/clinicschedule.html). On Day 1 from 6-8:30pm we will hold a free riding clinic for 4-H members. There will be a session for those 12 and under and a session for those 13 and over. See the HOW TO REGISTER section on the next page. Advance registration required. Each session is limited to 15 riders.

### **COST AND VALUE**

\$300 per rider, limit 12 riders per session, morning session 8-12, afternoon session 1-5. Cost includes riding both days in 1 session and observation of alternate session each days. A 50 % non-refundable deposit is due to reserve your spot, with the 50% balance due prior to the start of the clinic.

Grandstand seating is available for auditing, which is \$25 / day (free to 4-H members). Riding in both sessions each day is \$500/rider. Stalls are \$15/day and you must provide your own shavings. RV parking is available for \$20/day. Restrooms are available on site but there are no concessions.

### **EVENT TIME & LOCATION**

The clinic will run from 8AM to 5PM each day in 2 split riding sessions...8-12 and 1-5. On Saturday, March 3, the free 4-H clinic will be from 6PM to 7PM for those 12 and under and 7:30PM to 8:30PM for those 13 and over.
