



## **2 Day Horsemanship Clinic, Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Centre, Queen Creek, AZ, January 28-29, 2012, Outdoor Arena**

### **DESCRIPTION**

This clinic is for riders of any age and discipline who are interested in improving their horsemanship, want to learn how to better understand what their horse is thinking as well as how to provide appropriate leadership, or have a specific problem, such as bucking, rearing or head tossing, that you'd like to overcome. All horses must be broke to ride and riders must provide their own hay and supplements.

Kerry has earned a reputation in the clinic industry for being an incredible communicator with both horses and riders and emphasizes having fun as much as learning and safety. Clinic topics will include, but are not limited to:

- Creating willingness in both horse and rider
- Developing softness from head to tail
- Learning how to use fluid forward motion in your training
- Building total body control
- Overcoming anxiety in each of you / developing confidence
- Groundwork principles and exercises
- Passenger exercises
- Problem solving

### **COST AND VALUE**

\$300 per rider, limit 12 riders per session, morning session 8-12, afternoon session 1-5. Cost includes riding both days and observation of alternate session both days. A 50 % deposit is due to reserve your spot, with the 50% balance due prior to the start of the clinic. Grandstand seating is available for FREE AUDITING.

Stalls are \$15 / day and the facility does not allow outside bedding materials. Bedding is \$10 per day. RV parking is available for \$25 / day. Concessions and restrooms are also available on site.

The clinic will run from 8 AM to 5PM each day in 2 split riding sessions...8-12 and 1-5.
